

TOWN OF STAMFORD, VERMONT
CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

May 4, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 630 PM, opening with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present at the meeting were members Sheila Lawrence, David Saldo, Lisa Gardner and Irene Bergman.

Attending as guests were Diane Saldo and James and Debra Righi.

Board Members Sally Bohl and Nancy LaSage were not present.

The minutes of the July 15, 2025 meeting were accepted by Sheila Lawrence and seconded by David Saldo. All were in favor.

The investigation into water sources for the community was reported to be ongoing. Sheila Lawrence and Irene Bergman will continue to address this project. More information will be provided at future meetings. A discussion ensued on the water and sewerage issues on Main Road. More extensive studies will have to be conducted before any proposals are made.

It was reported that the Travel Counsel of Vermont is asking for a representative from each municipality located on Route 100 Scenic Highway be appointed. It is determined that there are complex issues regarding Scenic Route 100 the community has to look into restrictions imposed by the state on the designation. It was stated that if compliance is not adhered to, state funds could be withheld. It was noted that propositions 181 and 63 do not impact Stamford at this time as the town does not have municipal water or sewerage.

The board will discuss reorganization of officers for the coming year at the next meeting, providing all members are present.

The commission will have a brainstorming session at the next meeting to begin to develop a mission statement for the group to further focus and direct projects I the future.

The next meeting will be held on June 8, 2026 at 630PM.

Sheila made a motion to adjourn at 8PM which was seconded by David and all were in favor
