CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

JUNE 9, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:30PM, opening with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present at the meeting were members Sheila Lawrence, David Saldo, Lisa Gardiner and Irene Bergman, Guests attending were Diane Saldo and James and Debra Righi.

Not present were board members Nancy LaSage and Sally Bohl.

The minutes of the May 4, 2026 meeting were read and accepted by Sheila Lawrence and seconded by Lisa Garner. All were in favor.

Discussion ensued pertinent to reorganization of members for the coming year. Sheila Lawrence was nominated to retain chairmanship by Irene Bergman, seconded by David Saldo and all were in favor.

Lisa Gardiner was nominated by Sheila Lawrence for Vice Chairman for the coming term, seconded by Irene Bergman and all were in favor.

Irene Bergman was nominated by Sheila Lawrence to retain role as secretary for the group, seconded by David Saldo and all were in favor.

The group discussed priorities for the upcoming term and determined that water was the primary issue to work on. It was noted that potable water in the town particularly on Main Road was an ongoing problem within the community. A decision was reached to begin to investigate with the ANR funds availability for a feasibility study to address ongoing issue. It was noted that while this is a significant issue within the town, affordability to the community must be protected. Further discussion at next meeting and creative solutions will be brought to light at that time.

Work on the Mission Statement was deferred to a later date.

A motion to conclude meeting was put forth at 7:50PM by Irene Bergman, seconded by Lisa Gardiner and all were in favor.
